I. THE FOUR HORSES OF THE APOCALYPSE

(cf. Matt. 24:3-8)

Apocalypse means: “lifting of the veil” or “revelation”.
A disclosure of something hidden from the majority
of mankind.

A. First seal opened, the **white** horse emerges.

The rider personifies a **false peace**.

(Rev. 6:1-2; cf. Rev. 19:11, 16; II Thess. 2:9-11; Dan. 9:27a; Rev. 13:4; I Thess. 5:3)

B. Second seal opened, the **red** horse emerges.

The rider personifies **war**.

(Rev. 6:3-4; cf. Dan. 9:26; Matt. 24:6; Phil. 4:4-7)

C. Third seal opened, the **black** horse emerges.

The rider personifies **famine**. (Rev. 6: 5-6)

D. Fourth seal opened, the **pale green** horse emerges.

The rider personifies **death**.

(Rev. 6: 7-8; cf. Lk. 16:22ff; I Cor. 15:26; Rev. 21:4)
