### GROWTH GROUP STUDY QUESTIONS:

1. What is the significance of the word “soul” in understanding Psalm 103:1-5?
2. Discuss the distinction between “sin” and “humanity.”
3. We know that “God loves the world” but several times in Psalm 103:11-18, David qualifies God’s promises as “for those who fear Him.” Do non-believers experience God’s love, compassion and mercy? Discuss
4. David says in verse 5 that our soul’s youth will be renewed “like the eagle’s”. What is the significance of this imagery?
5. Review the definition of worship and discuss how a “Here, There and Everywhere” perspective of God should affect our daily life.
